Introducing The Land Trust



The Land Trust aims to nurture this green oasis for the benefit of residents and visitors, businesses and wildlife.

As Marleigh continues to develop, more areas of formal and natural green space, playgrounds, sports pitches and allotments will come under the management of Land Trust Residential Services from Hill and Marshall.

The new community has been designed to encourage neighbourliness and interaction. This includes a woodland trail, cycle facilities, play areas, wildlife ponds and a market square with splashpad – a cherished hub bounded by the community centre, café, office space, nursery school and primary school. There are also plans for retail space, sports pitches and allotments to sit alongside the new homes

There is so much to do in the great outdoors at Marleigh: walk, run, cycle, picnic, party, play, splash in the square, shop, read, meet for coffee, meander, pond dip, bird spot, plane spot, close your eyes, chill and chat.

Conservation, wildlife, flora and fauna

The landscape at Marleigh has been designed to help support a wide variety of natural life. Chalky former agricultural land, young broadleaves and Scots pine in the shelterbelt, together with newly planted trees and shrubs, provide good habitat for birds and other wildlife. Sustainable drainage ponds that extend for 500m provide shelter and food for a range of wildlife including amphibians, insects, birds, bats and other mammals.


